WHY CHRIST WAS MANIFESTED

LAGOS BAPTIST CONFERENCES' SCHOOLS GENERAL SCHOOL INFORMATION

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. "Isaiah 9:6"

To all Parents/Guardians,

Appreciation: We are grateful to God for bringing us to the end of the first term, 2023/2024 academic session, to Him alone be all the Glory and to all our parents, we are indeed grateful..

Admission for 2023/2024 Academic Session:

Admission forms are still on sale at the rate of #7,000 only in all our schools and the Directorate office at Isolo for JSS1, JSS2 & SS1 classes for those seeking transfer. You are reminded of the referral discounts. We count on you to be our Vanguard.

The School's stand on Misbehaviour: This is to re-emphasize that the school will remain firm in handling cases of misbehaviour. We appeal to parents to talk to their wards during the holidays to represent them well in school. The school handbook should be properly studied. We will not hold back to suspend or expel any student on account of gross misconduct.

Items to be checked on Resumption: The following items are to be checked before entering into the hostels: scrubbing brush, insecticide, broom, pyjamas for both (male & female), liquid soap, biro, mathematics sets and two dozens of pecks or clips for students uniform. Please ensure you come in with all of them. The liquid soap and pecks is for the students' personal use.

Uniform Identification: We encourage all our parents to ensure that the names of their wards are boldly written (monogrammed) on their uniforms for easy identification. Any uniform not monogrammed will be not be checked in. We also observed that some uniforms ought to have been replaced. Any trouser slim fitted or skirt that is adjusted from below the knee will not be allowed.

Dressing of Parents: We want to re-emphasize that parents should kindly be conscious of the dress they

wear to our school events as well as on visiting. We need to realize that we are dealing with children who learn more based on what they see. This is against the backdrop of previous experiences. The school will not hesitate to challenge any parent who undermines this counsel

School Fees: We do appreciate your sincere efforts in ensuring that you pay the school fees on time. Nevertheless, we encourage early payment on or before resumption in order to have your receipt written once payment is confirmed. It is highly imperative to indicate the name of your child when paying the school fee either online or through company's name.

Damage to school property: It should be noted that the willful damage of school property by any student will not be tolerated. Students found culpable of this shall bear the cost and possibly present them during the PTA meeting.

Contrabands: This is to re-iterate that items like sardines, perfume, liquid milk, pressing iron, phones, iron hanger, radio, video games etc, are contrabands and they will be seized once they are brought to school. The same goes for wrong cardigan. Please note that any phone seized shall be publicly destroyed, so ensure you check your ward's luggage before leaving the house.

Health Care: Kindly treat your ward for malaria and deworm them before they return to school for next session. Students who are on medication should be returned to school with the Doctors' prescription and medication. This should be handed over to the clinic staff.

Nail/Hair Cut: It is important to give your child/ward a CLEAN hair cut at home. Any questionable style or bushy hair will not be overlooked at resumption. The school does not tolerate long nails. Please inspect your child's nails at home.

Pick up of day students: For the day students, the parents will need to put in writing to the principal who drop and picks up their ward(s) after school. If the child is expected to come and leave school on his or her own,

it should as well be stated in the letter. This became necessary in response to happenings in our country and the need to be security conscious

Duration of Holiday: The school vacates today, Friday, 15th December 2023. The Boarders will resume on Sunday 7th January, 2024 from the hours of 12noon to 5.00pm (for Ijegan and Ikola) while the Day students will resume on Monday 8th January, 2024. Please do not bring your child to school at night. Parents who arrive after the stipulated time will not be allowed to come in. We plead with parents to arrive on or before 5:00pm.

Facelift: The continuation of our facelifting effort is ongoing across all our schools including the laying of kerbs at BMHS Agbowa. Students who damage any property of the school will take full responsibility.

SAT & TOEFL: Please note that some parents have already indicated interest in the SAT and TOEFL for their wards. The cost will be communicated by the principal to affected parents.

30th Anniversary: Baptist Model High Schools is 30 years on November 15, 2023. The 30th anniversary of celebration is schedule to hold from March 18-24, 2024. To this end, we shall have joint inter-house sports. However, the schools will hold their respective inter-house sports heat on date to be communicated by each school.

School-Parents Prayer: School-Parents Prayer will hold from next term during Visiting Days as we take our request and burden before the Almighty God who can do what no man can do.

Parents Academy: This will also commence where educative topics will be treated by invited guests both during PTA and other fora. This is to foster home-school relationship and to also equip our parents to face the challenges confronting younger generation.
